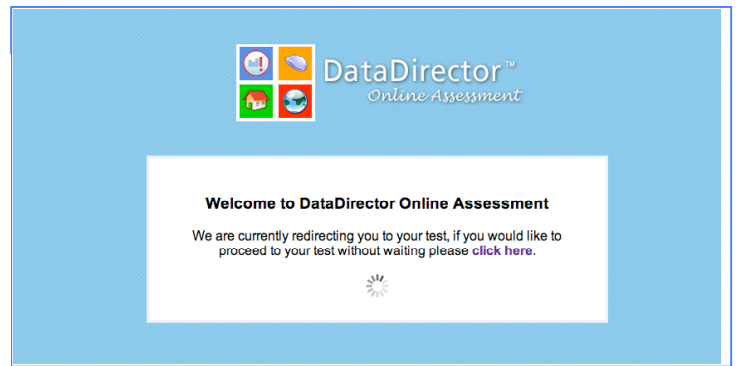


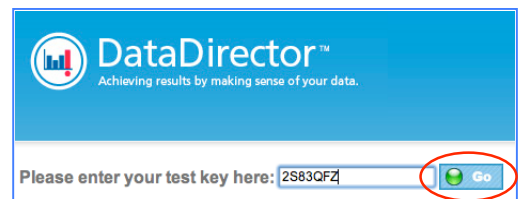
## Online Testing – Student Directions

### STEP 1: LOGGING IN

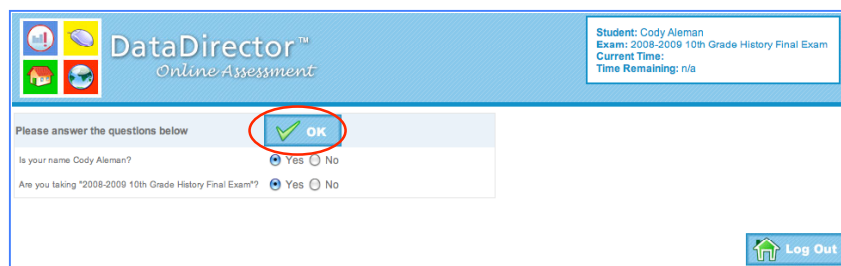
1. During the testing window time period, login to: [www.achievedata.com/](http://www.achievedata.com/)\_\_\_\_\_ /test.
